Mary, Mother of Mercy

Dear Confreres,

Greetings from Don Bosco Provincial House, Hyderabad. We are well into the month of May, a month dedicated to our Blessed Mother. In this year of 'Mercy' we are invited to contemplate God as our 'Merciful Father'. Jesus is the sign of the immeasurable Mercy of the Father. The primary purpose of the Extraordinary Jubilee Year of Mercy is to experience the abundant Mercy of God towards each one of us and to BE Merciful ourselves towards our neighbours.

Bonum est diffusivum sui - Goodness, by its very nature, is self-diffusive said St Thomas Aquinas. The unconditional mercy of God has this quality per se, and the greatest recipient of this mercy of God is the person closest to him, Mother Mary. As the greatest recipient of this Mercy she also in turn becomes the Mother of Mercy.

God's mercy is a concrete manifestation of His Grace. We, sinful as we are, can obtain God's grace only through his abundant and unconditional mercy. The first person to experience this abundant grace of God, is our Mother, whom God himself addressed as 'full of grace'. She was able to receive the fullness of grace and mercy, because of an attitude of surrender, of unworthiness expressed through her *fiat... Behold the handmaid of the Lord...* (Lk 1,38). This complete surrender and humility enabled her to bear God in her womb. The humble acceptance of the abundant mercy of the Father made of her the bearer of Christ for the world.

We find ourselves, inserted and surrounded by a relativistic society which has lost the sense of sin. The *magisterium*, time and again has reminded us of the loss of the sense of sin in our modern times. From Pope Pius XII who declared that, "*the sin of the century is the loss of sense of sin*" to Pope Francis who warns us, "*The year of mercy makes sense only if you haven't lost the sense of sin.*"

As we look up to our Mother of Mercy, we are called to become aware of our lowliness, our brokenness and our unworthiness. This awareness of our human condition will create in us a thirst for the abundant, healing mercy of God. Once we open our hearts, sinful and

sorrowful to the mercy of God, we ourselves will become bearers of Christ to the world like Mother Mary. She is the perfect example of God's transforming grace and mercy, which takes our sinful and fragile nature, and makes of it a vessel, a medium, a channel of God's presence to the world. From her immaculate conception to her glorious assumption into heaven, God fashioned her to be the created masterpiece of his mercy in the World. Our *Fiat*, our humble surrender and openness to the mercy of God, will create of us masterpieces of His mercy in the world.

The Mother of Mercy is also for us a model of being agents of mercy to others. It is a known fact that one can give only what one has. Mary, Mother of Mercy, received this abundant, unconditional mercy of the Father and being full of His grace, she became an agent of mercy herself to the people around her. Her extraordinary acts of mercy start from the moment of the annunciation, where she went in haste to serve her cousin Elizabeth. It is at this encounter, that the eulogy to the mercy of God is proclaimed through her *Magnificat*. She becomes an agent of God's providential grace at the marriage feast of Cana. Her comforting presence with Jesus on his journey to Calvary and at the foot of the Cross, is also an icon of God's mercy to us.

As we venerate and honour, Mary, our Mother as the Mother of Mercy, we are also called as her loving children, to follow her footsteps and learn from her, as to how to become agents of God's Mercy, especially to members of our own communities and the people with whom we share our life.

Salesian Saints of the month

St Dominic Savio (6 May): Dominic Savio was born at Riva di Chieri, Italy on 2 April 1842, in a poor family, yet a family that was rich when it came to religious values. He was

totally dedicated to God and from a very young age, showed signs of holiness. At Valdocco, he discovered the higher perspectives of the life he was called to live, the road to holiness and understood well the self-donation to God that he needed to make. His life was lived in joy, nourished with great devotion to the sacraments and to our Blessed Mother. He was canonized a saint on 12 June 1954.

St Mary Mazzarello (13 May): Saint Mary Mazzarello is the fertile root of the tree of feminine Salesianity, not only sharing in the charism of foundation but also being herself endowed with an outstanding gift of the Holy Spirit springing forth as a new foundation. The title of co-foundress therefore is the one which gives her the greatest prominence, because it denotes the position which is uniquely and specifically hers. In fact, Mary Mazzarello is not just the cornerstone and the first superior of the Institute but also the one who, in virtue of a special gift of the Holy Spirit integrates, completes, enriches and gives a specifically feminine touch to Don Bosco's charismatic action in founding the Institute.

She generated life because she knew to die to herself like her Lord and Master Jesus Christ. Today if she wears the crown of unfading glory it is because she lived constantly under the shadow of the cross. Let us learn from the school of our master, the Lord of creation and the world around us that only by dying to ourselves can we rise to a new life and colour the world with love as did our saint.


Saint Leonard Murialdo (18 May): He was amongst those fostering the first popular Catholic Libraries and Catholic Workers Unions, and would be their ecclesiastical assistant for many years. In 1873, with the support of some helpers, he founded the Congregation of Saint Joseph (Giuseppini of Murialdo). Their apostolic purpose was the education of youth, especially the poor and abandoned. He opened oratories, technical schools, family homes for young workers including young farmers, and took on further commitment in lay associations, especially in the field of technical formation of the young and printing works. His motto was *fare e tacere* (Do and be silent!). He was a spiritual person and a man of prayer, a contemplative in action like Don Bosco.

The Solemnity of Mary Help of Christians

Devotion to Mary Help of Christians is part of our DNA as Salesians. For our father, Don Bosco, Mary Help of Christians was his guide, teacher and principal patroness. All that he accomplished in his life time, he attributed to the maternal intervention of Mary. As faithful sons of Don Bosco, it is our duty and our privilege to celebrate in a very fitting manner the feast of Our Blessed Mother, Mary Help of Christians. I am sure that all of us, in our institutions and parishes will celebrate the novena and the feast in a solemn

manner. Let us not spare any effort to spread devotion to our Mother. I wish you all a very happy Feast of Mary Help of Christians. May the Mother of Mercy's constant intercession and intervention guide us.
