... and Mary said, 'YES'

We are in the month of May. A month dedicated Mother Mary and a month dear to us Salesians as we honor her as Mary, Help of Christians. In Nazareth, there is a majestic Basilica dedicated to the Annunciation. This basilica is built around what is said to be the house of Mother Mary. At the heart of the Basilica is a grotto, at the center of which stands an Altar in white. On this altar are inscribed the words, '*verbum caro hic factum est.*' (The Word became flesh, Here). This is the place where the angel Gabriel presented to Mary the request of the Father and it was Mary's response which changed the world forever. Her response though small, was enough for God to take flesh and become one of us.

Mary said: 'YES'

Since we have the perspective of knowing the rest of the story, it is difficult for us to comprehend the depth of Mary's faith. This young girl in all probability did not understand, what was asked of her. But her Yes was total, unconditional. It was this small yet unmitigated, unreserved Yes that made way for God to put into action his salvific plan.

Mary's journey does not end with her saying YES. Her YES meant being a pregnant unwed mother, the consequence of which was being stoned to death according to the Mosaic Law. Her YES meant giving birth to a child in a dirty stable. Her YES meant an arduous journey to Egypt, fleeing from Herod who wanted to kill her son. Her YES meant seeing her only Son die on the Cross naked, like a criminal. She could not have possibly imagined that she would undergo all these sufferings or even the incredible blessings she would receive. She never retraced or reconsidered her YES.

The same God seeks even now from us that unconditional yet simple YES. An answer to his divine plan so vast, so profound and so seemingly impossible that you and I cannot comprehend it. Can we

respond to God's call like Mary with our availability and willingness, to incarnate Christ in our lives living in communities, through the mission entrusted to us. We often fall prey to the temptation of human calculations and personal agendas. Can we be courageous enough to trust God as Mary did, allow him to guide our lives?

From the moment she said YES, from the manger to the cross, Mary's life was radically changed – her relationship with God profoundly deepened. Each time we say YES and commit ourselves to embracing God's call and accepting His will, we mark a new point on the path of our relationship with Him. With this circular I am presenting to you the list of transfers. While I thank you dear confreres for the valuable service that you have rendered in the past year(s), I wish you a fruitful ministry in the new place of apostolate. Transfers come into effect from 24 May.
